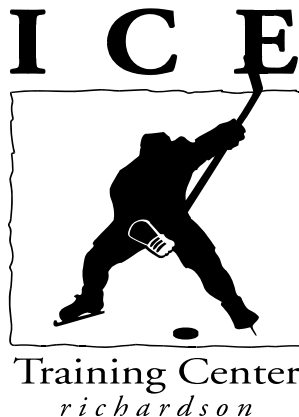

The Goal of The Program

As team and individual skills progress players will participate in cross ice games where they can showcase their individual skills. Divisions

All participants will be tested and placed into the proper division.

Majors

Players in the Major division will be able to skate across the ice unassisted, be proficient in or show beginnings of backwards skating, and be proficient in or show beginnings in stopping along with crossovers. Players will be provided with a patient and educational learning environment that emphasizes the importance of all basic skills. Players will be encouraged to push themselves to master their own individual skills and discover how to apply these skills in a team environment.

Minors

Players in the Minor division will focus on basic skating skills such as falling/getting up, marching on the ice, beginning swizzles, and most importantly confidence on the ice. Players will participate in fun games designed to utilize their new skills. The ultimate goal is for the Minor division players to be able to progress through the Majors program and then move on to our Mini-Mite program. Some individual players may progress and be able to participate sooner than others.
